This white tarpaulin allows you to quickly create a clean, safe and private enclosure around construction sites, storage zones or backstage areas. The sheets are sized to match standard temporary fences: 3.50 metres wide and 1.80 metres high. Reinforced hems with brass eyelets make it easy to attach the tarpaulin to fences using cable ties (not included). Our tarpaulin range is available in multiple colours and materials, so there's always a suitable solution for every situation and project.

Reliable fire-retardant material

The NVO-certified material is flame-retardant and enhances overall site safety. It complies with DIN 4102 B1 (DIN EN 13501), the strict European safety standard used by fire departments and event organisations. A B1 classification means the tarpaulin is highly fire-resistant, making it suitable for high-traffic or sensitive locations.

Tips for reinforcing the fencing line

When fencing is fitted with tarpaulin, it catches more wind. That's why we recommend installing your fencing semi-permanently using ground-mounted posts and fastening the panels with fence clamps. If semi-permanent installation isn't possible, you can reinforce the setup with struts and concrete feet. Not all fence panels are suitable for tarpaulin use, our specialists are happy to advise you and can also provide full installation support.
